

# Health & Safety - Method Statement

## Process for Commercial Wheeled Waste Container Cleaning

Resources:	Vehicles and operators as required.
Consumables:	Water (recycled). Virosol Cleaner 100ml per 100 litres water. Zoflora Bouquet Disinfectant / Deodoriser 100 ml per 5 litres water. Technical / Safety Data Sheets available for Virosol & Zoflora products.
Planning:	Client Schedule / Requirements. Client address / preferred cleaning location. Client contact name. Client contact telephone number. Special considerations / restrictions.
Process: (Risk assessment)	Collect waste containers from client storage. (Ensure access is clear with no restrictions). (Ensure container residue contents are acceptable and non-hazardous, ask client if unsure). Push containers to the cleaning unit. (Ensure no hazard to pedestrians / vehicles / property). (Ensure container weight is not excessive). Raise container to wash position with the lift. (Ensure all personnel at safe distance) Wash internal surfaces with hand held wash lance. (Ensure spray / mist escape is minimal and not breathed). Allow water to drain back into water recycle system. (None identified). Lower container for visual inspection. (Ensure all personnel are clear of drop zone). Pressure wash external surfaces including lid. (Ensure no spray affects surrounding persons or property). Lift container and repeat wash / rinse / drain procedure. (See above risks)

## Process for Commercial Wheeled Waste Container Cleaning continued

Process: (Risk assessment)	Inspect container after each wash until the required standard is met. (None identified). Spray internal surfaces and underside of lid with disinfectant / deodoriser. (Ensure spray is kept local and not breathed). Return container to client preferred location / storage site. (Ensure no hazard to personnel, vehicles and property).
